

## **Minutes NCRC Meeting January 14, 2013**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM by John Mills. Ten members were present.

The members were informed that a special meeting would be required to elect a new President and Vice President, as those positions had been vacated due to personal reasons. The election will be held on February 11<sup>th</sup> (The next Regular Meeting date). The nominating committee will present a list of candidates by the election date.

A Treasurer's Report was given covering year-end 2012. Net assets of the club are \$3728.54. This does NOT include the \$3000 grant received by the club, but those funds have already been committed. This report also included a Income/Expense statement for the prior 12 months that indicates the club is running at almost break-even factoring in the latest dues increase. The largest expense item was insurance (\$516) and John Mills indicated he would check into lower cost alternatives. The Treasurer's Report was approved by the membership.

Some discussion was made concerning proposed bylaws changes. In particular a large number of unfilled "committee" chairs were mentioned. Work on the bylaws is ongoing.

A motion was made to hold a Technican Class at the Red Cross facility starting April 1<sup>st</sup> and running through May 6<sup>th</sup> (exam date). This motion was passed unanimously. A discussion of the class fee ensued. It was decided to charge the student half the cost of the book, with the other half coming out of the \$3000 IBM grant (the club sought and received permission to purchase up to 20 books for training purposes).

The secretary was directed to purchase a new sign-in book for use at club meetings.

After the close of regular business, a presentation was made by Bob Beatty, WB4SON, describing a "NTP Clock" based on the low-cost Raspberry PI . A copy of the presentation was placed on the club website.
