It is recommended that the NCO repeat the Invitation to check in every 5-10 minutes until 2000. At NCO's discretion further check-ins may be invited thereafter, however to keep the number of check-ins manageable, he/she may terminate taking additional check-ins at 2000.

It might be wise to appoint a Net Manager, in order to maintain records of the weekly sessions of the net, including: the date of the session, the name and Call Sign of the NCO, and the number of Check-ins, in addition to the time of commencement and conclusion of the net.
