Popular "Logging" Programs

- DXKeeper (DXlabs) Most popular DX hunter logging program
- N1MM+ Most popular contest logging/control program
- Ham Radio Deluxe (HRD) Complicated swiss army knife does everything
- Amateur Contact Log (ACL) Most popular general logging program

MANY more out there. Some free. Some not. The four above are the biggies in their perspective area.

DXKeeper

- Part of DXLabs Suite (<u>http://www.dxlabsuite.com</u>)
- This is THE Logging program for DX Hunters
- Very "DOS" like old feel. Separate programs (nine of them) to do different tasks (like spotting, logging, rig control)
- Author is very responsive to bug fixes, and very active Yahoo group support
- Free

N1MM+

- http://www.nlmm.hamdocs.com
- Most popular contest logger by FAR
- Not really a general purpose logging program
- Full rig control for sending exchanges CW/DATA/even SSB
- Easy to use but fairly complex setup
- Support via Yahoo group. Extensive WIKI with videos
- Free

Ham Radio Deluxe

- http://www.ham-radio-deluxe.com
- Highest level of integration of digital modes, logging, rig control, even satellite
- Complicated to setup and use
- Support via a custom "ticket" system for paid support users. VERY POOR response time. Bugs take years to fix. Support staff often rude.
- \$100 to buy plus \$50 a year for support

Amateur Contact Log

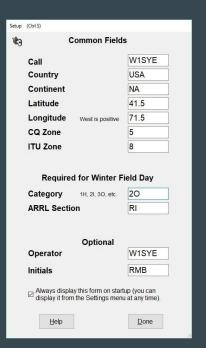
- http://www.n3fjp.com
- Most popular logging ONLY program
- Easiest to setup and use BY FAR
- Can receive frequency/mode info from modern radio
- Supports MANY contests
- Not really intended to for full station control
- Support via email or Yahoo group (never taken more than a few hours for a response via email)
- Costs \$50 for full package, \$25 for ACL, \$9 for individual contests

Setting up ACL

- Almost any Windows PC will do (very low CPU/GPU requirements)
- Download the contest you want (or the general purpose log)
- Enter your call sign and license key (sent via email)
- Enter your operator information (location, call, operator name/initials)
- Select your radio interface
- Start logging!

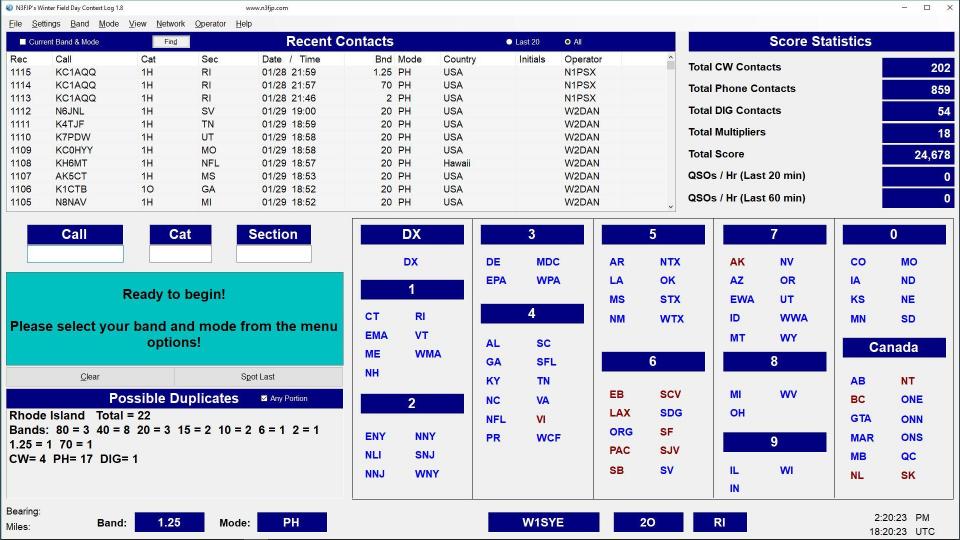
ACL Setup

- Shows on startup or settings/setup choice
- General ACL has Call/Country.../Zone info
- Contest have required data like 2O for WFD
 Or 2A for Field Day
- Enter your Operator Initials at the bottom!



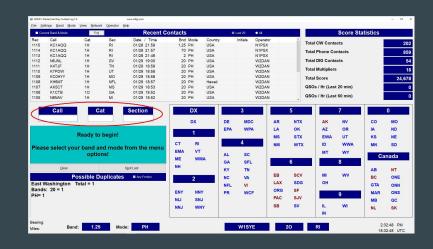
Using ACL

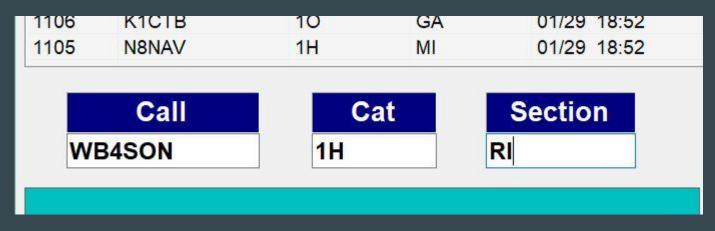
- Pretty much everything you need to know is on a single screen
- Just enter info for the other station (call, exchange, contest details, etc.)
- Easy to export to an ADIF file, do Cabrillo Contest files, lotw, eqsl, etc.



Adding a Contact to the log

- Look for area near left/center
- Add in contact details (call/exchange)
- Frequency/Time/Mode automatic

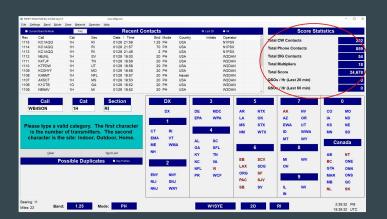




Keeping Track of Progress

- Upper Right Corner of screen dedicated to progress
- Score is good to know but RATES tell story!

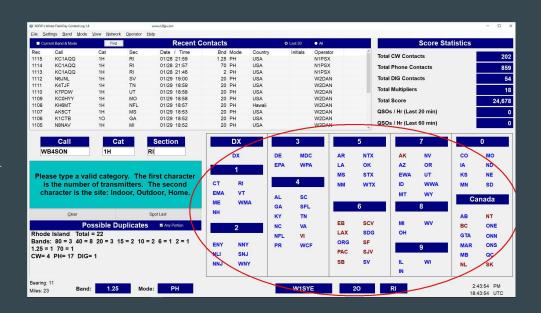

Sections/Multipliers

Some contests keep track of sections (Field Day does NOT), but they are Listed which helps you get it right

Red highlighted ones are still needed



Suggests possible call signs

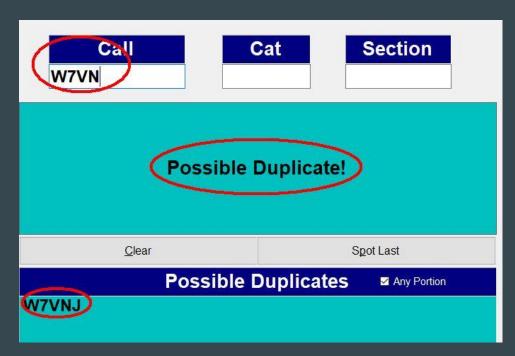
- Bottom-left corner of screen
- Enter a part of a callsign and ACL suggests common contesters
- In example to right, typing "W1S" in the Call Box pops up a list of 15 calls.
- Sure enough W1SYE is in there!



Duplicates

- Program will warn of a possible duplicate callsign
- Actual Duplicate big red warning
- Can't enter a duplicate contact

By the way, don't mention it to the Other operator -- Just move on!



Fixing a Mistake

- So quick and easy to enter a contact
- Fixing a mistake real break of "flow"
- Go to upper-right. Newest at top
- Click on desired entry and click
- Click on Edit box
