Saturday morning)*

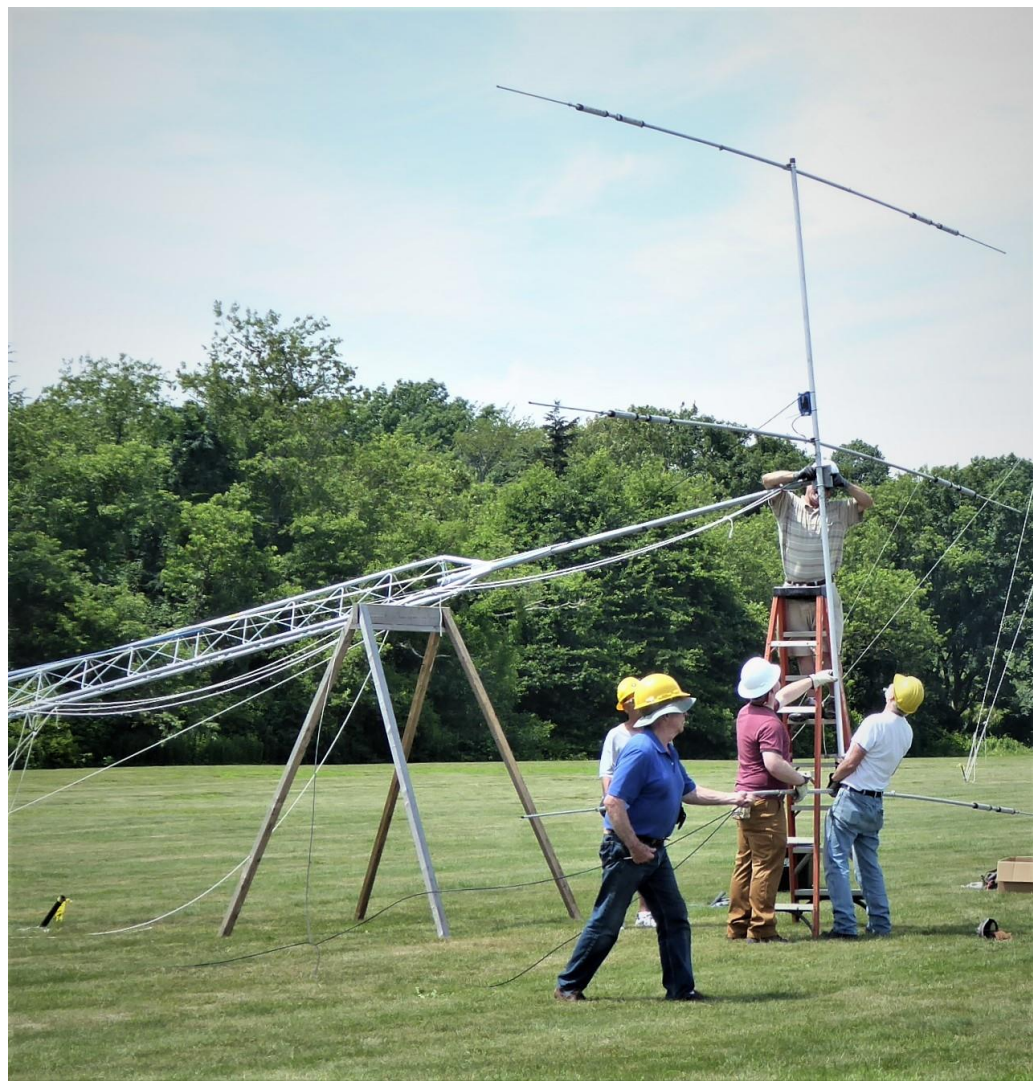
*Besides the contesting, some
