- Get On The Air (GOTA) Station SSB voice (HF)
 This is the station for new hams and prospective hams. Anyone licensed within the past year may operate. Unlicensed people may operate under the supervision of a control operator. Coaches will be on duty at all times.
- VHF Station SSB Voice or CW operator's choice (Digital possible?)
 Any licensed ham may operate this station. Primary operations will be on 6 meters. Operation is permitted on any band above 50 MHz. Seats available for anyone wishing to operate.
- Fone Station Primarily SSB Voice plus CW shift (HF)
 Rapid-fire contest operation for seasoned contest operators. Some seats may be available. Previous contest experience required.
- CW Station CW only (HF)
 Rapid-fire CW contest operation for seasoned CW contest operators. Fully subscribed.
