The November 14, 2022 meeting was called to order at 7:08 PM by Nancy, KC1NEK. There were 40 members present (21 in-person and 19 unique zoom users).

The minutes of the October meeting were approved by the membership.

One new applicant, Jeremy Dennis, was voted into membership and hopes to take his tech exam in December. The roster has 177 dues paying members.

Mike AA1XQ explained that the next VE session would be held on December 10th at St Barnabas. No one has signed up to date. There will be a VE training session on how to use the ExamTools system this coming weekend.

Ted, W1GRI, resigned as Treasurer last week after many years of service to the club. Pursuant to the bylaws, the President appointed John Jackman, N1SMX, to be acting Treasurer. The club members voted to approve John's position.

The next order of business was to point out that the club's bylaws currently state that BOTH the President and Vice President may serve only 2 consecutive terms. Of course Paul K1YBE is at the end of his 3rd consecutive term, and he was nominated for a 2023 term as well. After consultation with past members and the Executive Committee (EC), no one could come up with a valid reason to prevent the VP from serving multiple terms (it was pointed out that it was assumed that the VP would become the income President in most cases). Therefore the EC decided to modify the club bylaws. The original text of Article 3, Section 4, and the proposed revised test, are reproduced below, and were read to the club members. A second reading will be held at the December 12th meeting, at which point the membership can vote for the changes if they desire.

## Original text:

Section 4) The office of President and Vice President may be held by any one member for only two (2) consecutive terms. However, such member may again be elected to either office after a lapse of one (1) term.

## Revised Text:

Section 4) The office of President may be held by any one member for only two (2) consecutive terms. However, such member may again be elected to office after a lapse of one (1) term.

With that explanation of the issue with the Vice President term limit, the following slate of officers was presented to the membership, which unanimously voted to accept them as their officers for 2023
