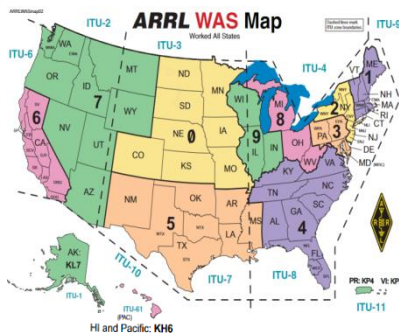
US amateur radio **callsigns** contain one or two prefix letters: W, K, N, AA-AL, KA-KZ, NA-NZ, WA-WZ
